The 2021 Alberta Cancer Foundation Golf Classic raised \$370,000 net for the Patient Financial Assistance Program. With your support, patients and families are able to receive financial support during their treatment, so they can focus on what matters most -healing.

Cancer can be a huge strain on finances. People are often forced to cash in their retirement funds and use up their savings to make ends meet during treatment. The costs can be so overwhelming that some patients will decide against having life-saving therapy and instead choose a lesser treatment as they simply cannot afford the out-of-pocket expenses for items such as medications, medical supplies, transportation, accommodations and child care.

Last year, the Patient Financial Assistance Program was accessed **more than 4,933 times** by **over 926 families** across Alberta.
